**Benefits and Opportunities:** The GMSEC provides a laptop, all testing, instruction materials, and a fleet vehicle for your use. We have a great health insurance offering in which the Co-op offers a significant contribution that typically covers the majority of the cost of a health plan. For family/spouse plans it covers a great deal of the cost and our flex plan allows for your cost to come out of your check pre-tax. We set aside funding to support continuous professional development for all staff. Currently, the school psychologists meet once a month as a department to discuss programs, evaluations, and the development of and participation in programs such as MTSS that supports truly integrated programs within our districts.

**Education and Experience:** Master's degree in School Psychology and completed supervised internship. Eligible for Class VI School Psychologist Specialist Certification for Montana. Individuals eligible for Montana Class V endorsement will be considered and provided with on-site supervision for required clinical experience. GMSEC has a competitive salary matrix that accepts years of experience. Annual salary for a 187-day contract is depending on experience and credits beyond. An annual "national certification" stipend of \$2,000 is provided for those that qualify. School Psychologists in their internship year can also be considered with required supervision provided.
